NOTIFICATION

No.AD/PSRA/Events/111/Admn/Summer/Vacations/2026-27. This is in pursuance of this Authority's earlier notifications regarding Summer Vacations and Summer Camp for private schools in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa & the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Elementary & Secondary Education Department Circular dated 29-06-2026, whereby it has been directed that **no educational institution shall keep schools open or call students for academic or co-curricular activities after 30th June, 2026.**

2. All Private Schools are hereby informed that the Summer Camp period notified for the month of June, 2026 has formally concluded. Accordingly, all academic classes, summer camps, remedial sessions, orientation classes, coaching sessions, examinations, meetings involving student attendance, and any other on-campus student activities shall stand discontinued with immediate effect after 30th June, 2026, until reopening as per the notified academic calendar.

3. Moreover, the province is presently experiencing **extreme weather conditions**, including intense heat and prolonged exposure to high temperatures, which may seriously affect the health and safety of students as many students commute over long distances and remain exposed to direct sunlight during travel, thereby multiplying health risks of heat exhaustion, dehydration, heatstroke, fatigue, fainting, and other heat-related medical emergencies;

4. It is further conveyed that **any private school, found in violations, shall render itself liable to regulatory proceedings**, including issuance of a show cause notice, imposition of penalties, suspension of registration, or any other action permissible under the **KP-PSRA Act, 2017, and Regulations, 2018.**

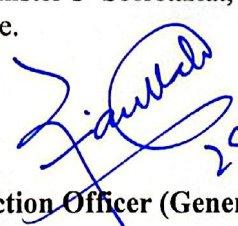

In case of any violation, strict disciplinary and legal actions should be taken against the defaulting institutions in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations.

NOTIFICATION

No.SO(G)/E&SED/1-48/2025/Summer Vacations. In continuation and in partial modification of this department notification of even number dated 25th May, 2026, the following guidelines / instructions are hereby issued for the successful conduct of Summer Camp in all summer zone schools of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. **These guidelines are applicable for all Summer Zone Schools (both Public & Private) in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa w.e.f. 1st June, 2026 to 30th June, 2026: -**

- i. The students of primary grades KG, I & II shall be exempted from the summer camp while students of grades III, IV and V and middle grades (VI, VII & VIII) shall attend summer camp for the subjects of English, Urdu, Mathematics and General Science/General Knowledge as per schedule already notified i.e. 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM (each class @ 30 minutes duration).
- ii. Foundational Literacy & Numeracy (FLN) for Primary Grades (III – V) and Remedial Learning shall be the primary areas of focus. Activity/Project based learning approach shall be adopted to cover learning losses in the academic year 2025-26. - iii. Students of middle grades (VI – VIII) shall attend the summer camp in accordance with the schedule already notified (7:00 AM – 9:00 AM) w.e.f. 1st June 2026 to 30th June 2026. Schools shall conduct comprehensive orientation of the new courses and connected SLOs of the subjects (English, Math, G/Science & Urdu). Special emphasis shall be placed on conceptual and SLO-based learning, diagnostic assessment, activity-based instruction, and project-based learning to enhance students' understanding and academic performance.
- iv. Students of High/Higher Secondary grades shall attend the summer camp in accordance with the schedule already notified (07:00 AM – 9:40 AM) w.e.f. 1st June 2026 to 30th June 2026. Schools shall conduct comprehensive orientation of the new courses and connected SLOs of the subjects already notified vide the above-mentioned notification. However, HSSC students appearing for annual practical examinations shall be exempted only for the days of their practical's dates notified by the BISEs.
- v. During the summer camp, schools shall focus exclusively on academic and learning activities. Students shall not be engaged in morning assemblies, sports events, Bazm-e-Adeb activities, guest speaker sessions, or any other co-curricular activities, so as to ensure that maximum time is devoted to teaching and learning.
- vi. The Directorate of Curriculum and Teacher Education (DCTE), Abbottabad, shall conduct assessment of schools based on the tasks assigned during the summer camp. The evaluation process shall be completed by 29th June, 2026, and the findings shall be submitted to the competent authority for further action. Based on this evaluation, the best teachers and students at the district level shall be awarded with awards/cash prizes. District Education Officers (DEOs) shall organize closing ceremonies on 30th June, 2026 in their respective districts. The event shall comprise of an award ceremony, student projects exhibition, and jubilation activities highlighting the achievements and outcomes of the summer camp. The representative of the Provincial Government at the district level shall distribute awards and certificates among the best-performing teachers and students in recognition of their outstanding performance and contributions.
- vii. All teachers shall remain present and shall perform their duties assigned by the school heads during the summer camp.

- viii. The school management shall ensure provision of basic facilities like clean drinking water, running washrooms and electricity etc.
- ix. All officers of the Directorate of E&SE and District Education Offices, including ASDEOs and School Leaders, shall essentially visit schools during the Summer Camp and shall spend a minimum of two hours per day in schools to facilitate, monitor, and support the implementation of summer camp activities. The DEOs shall develop comprehensive visit schedules and ensure strict compliance with the same.
- x. The Director General, Education Monitoring Authority shall mobilize the monitoring workforce to visit the schools during the summer camp and submit a comprehensive report at its conclusion.
- xi. During the summer camp, all the schools shall conduct comprehensive Enrollment Campaign to achieve the enrollment targets set by the E&SED.
- xii. All schools (including private and public sector) shall not extend the summer camp timing beyond 10:00 AM in any case.
- xiii. Double shift schools shall participate in summer camp for the notified hours in the morning only in those schools where additional rooms are available to accommodate students.

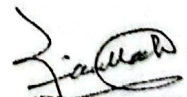
