- 1) Extend full cooperation to their respective Union Council Polio Officers and polio teams.
- 2) Provide the list of children under 5 years of age, in the prescribed format shared by UC Polio Officers / Area Supervisors/ Polio teams. (Prescribe format is hereby attached)
- 3) Facilitate campaign phases including micro-census, microplanning, and intra-campaign vaccination.
- 4) Ensure timely communication with parents regarding campaign dates to avoid delays in vaccination.

The Polio Campaign's success relies on strong coordination between schools and polio workers to ensure every eligible child is vaccinated. Your continued support and prompt action in guiding private schools are appreciated.
