Subject: REQUEST OF FACILITATION FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF FOURTH ROUND OF DEWORMING CAMPAIGN UNDER "DEWORMING INITIATIVE OF SCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN IN KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA".

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to state that the Health Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is committed to provide continuous enhance health care services to the general public despite humongous challenges like the COVID-19 pandemic and Poliomyelitis Virus eradication. Another worrisome situation which has emerged recently is the grave nutritional health status of school age children in the province. The World Health Organization (WHO) survey report (2016-17) concluded that there is growth stunting in almost 40% of Children in Pakistan. The key reason behind this, in general, is Soil Transmitted Helminthic Infections (STHI/worm infection) which were found to be highly prevalent in the twenty-two (22) districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, where-in the normal growth rate of school-age children are at risk due to STHIs.

Following this, the Government of Pakistan launched the Pakistan Deworming Initiative (PDI) in 2018. Subsequently, the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa launched KPD in 2019. A Multi-Sectoral Steering Committee was notified on June 21st, 2018 while for planning and implementation at district level, District Management Committees (DMCs) were notified on June 11th, 2019. Since then KPDI has conducted three successful rounds of Deworming Campaigns in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, with the extra-ordinary support and cooperation, landed by sister Departments and District Administration, which has led to the deworming of more than 2.7 million, 3.8 million and 5 million school-age children across 22 high risk districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, in 2019, 2021 and 2022 respectively.

The fourth round of deworming campaigns for the year 2024 is planned to be conducted from 14th to 18th October, 2024 in the 22 at risk districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. In this regard, your good office is humbly requested to kindly extend full support to the DMCs and KPDI in the planning & implementation of the fourth round of Deworming Campaigns in the province.

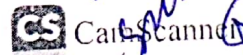
